

- The freedom to study the software and make changes to it.

# The Danger of Ebooks

In an age where business dominates our governments and writes our laws, every technological advance offers business an opportunity to impose new restrictions on the public. Technologies that could have empowered us are used to chain us instead.

#### With printed books,

- · You can buy one with cash, anonymously.
- · Then you own it.
- · You are not required to sign a license that restricts your use of it.
- · The format is known, and no proprietary technology is needed to read the book.
- You can give, lend or sell the book to another.
- You can, physically, scan and copy the book, and it's sometimes lawful under copyright.
   Nobody has the power to destroy your book.

#### Contrast that with Amazon ebooks (fairly typical):

- · Amazon requires users to identify themselves to get an ebook.
- In some countries, including the US, Amazon says the user cannot own the ebook.
- Amazon requires the user to accept a restrictive license on use of the ebook.
- The format is secret, and only proprietary user-restricting software can read it at all.

### The books category is closing

Starting April 2, 2019, the books category in Microsoft Store will be closing. Unfortunately, this means that starting July 2019 your ebooks will no longer be available to read, but you'll get a full refund for all book purchases. See below for details.

While you can no longer purchase or acquire additional books from the Microsoft Store, you can continue to read your books until July 2019 when refunds will be processed.

Will I be able to buy, rent or pre-order books after April 2, 2019?

No. On April 2, 2019, you can no longer buy, rent or pre-order books. You can continue to use


Let's leave libraries out of it for a moment. When a consumer pays money in order to access an eBook, that consumer is *not* buying that eBook. That transaction is more accurately described as paying for a license to access the book. The consumer never owns the eBook and the seller ultimately retains control of it, even when the consumer downloads it to their device.

The freedom to read requires ethical e-books.


- Shanty markup language (Licensed under GFDL)


